

# 2025 General All-Star Information

#### All-Star Selection & Eligibility

Our responsibility is to ensure that each league is following the USA Softball rules for All-Star eligibility and <u>forming teams according to your league by-laws</u>. Please make sure to review your league's written policies for All-Star team selection and follow that process. Each year we field complaints about leagues straying from their written policies so let's head that off this year. And please remember that you can not form teams before the last Saturday in April (26th). Please review the All-Star Team Eligibility Sheet attached to this email to ensure all players are eligible.

#### Classification

We will be classifying teams prior to the start of the tournaments this year. A league representative must fill out a request form with detailed information. The Google Forms must be completed by May 9<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Team Eligibility Form**

All teams entering the All-Star season must attest that their individual players and team have and will continue to follow the basic eligibility guidelines set forth by USA Softball. This form is due May 16<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Rosters**

The league registrars for each league are responsible for the creation of All-Star rosters in <a href="https://www.registerUSAsoftball.com">www.registerUSAsoftball.com</a>. Step-by-step instructions will be sent directly to the league registrar. Rosters are due in the system by May 9<sup>th</sup> so they can be approved in the system and then distributed back to coaches with time to collect parent signatures prior to the May 16<sup>th</sup> deadline.

#### **Mandatory Meeting & Required Paperwork**

The mandatory coaches meeting is May 18<sup>th</sup> via Zoom.. Each team should have 2 representatives present (manager + head coach). Presidents are welcome to attend.

Teams will be required to email items prior to this meeting. Please review the All-Star Team Checklist attached to this email. Required items are: Championship Roster, Entry Form, Coaches Form, Eligibility Form and Birth Certificates for each player.

#### **Tournament Schedule**

As your teams begin to plan out their summer, please be aware that your team can play in any invitational tournament listed on TournamentUSAsoftball.com that is within the correct classification. You are NOT permitted to play in any other affiliation (USSSA, AST, PGF Legacy, etc) or the team will be reclassified as a travel team (Class A).

#### **Signing Up For Tournaments**

All tournament sign-ups will happen through Tourney Machine, which is a new system to our organization. Go to <a href="www.tournamentUSAsoftball.com">www.tournamentUSAsoftball.com</a> and select "CA-Sacramento" from the dropdown. The local tournaments will be listed (the list also includes Class A and Adult tournaments). Please see the Tourney Machine Registration instructions attached to this email. It is crucial that sign-ups happen by the TEAM representative and not the league president on behalf of all teams. Any tournament communication will go ONLY to the person signing up the team. This should be the manager or head coach.

You will receive the ROSTER, ENTRY FORM and COACHES FORM from your League Registrar who will print it out from RegisterUSA.

**Championship Roster** *Must be printed double sided and there must be a parent signature for each rostered player. Manager must fill out the back side affidavit.* 

**Entry Form** Please write-in the manager contact information NEXT to the Team Admin info which was automatically generated by the system.

Official Junior Olympic Championship Tournament Requirements "Coaches Form": Ensure all coaches are listed on this form and at least one member has ACE Certification.

**Eligibility Form** *Fill* out completely to determine eligibility and have both the manager and president of the league sign off on the form.

**Birth Certificates** Birth certificates must be turned in for all players. Some may not be required if they have been previously verified. Your League Registar can give you a list of required birth
